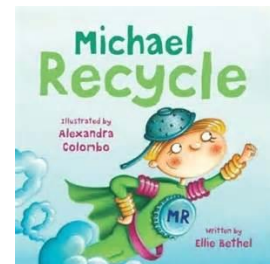


**Stars of the Week**
